Before you pack your bags, call us with your travel dates and destination to continue using your ATM and/or



Visa Debit card without interruption outside the US. Without receiving notice, transactions performed in an unfamiliar location may be automatically blocked to protect your account from fraudulent activity. Keep your finances safe and enjoy peace of mind when you travel.

Don't Let Your Account Go Dormant!

Members who have not had any activity in their account for 12 consecutive months incur a \$5 fee each month the account remains inactive.

Set yourself a reminder to make at least one deposit or withdrawal at least once every year.



- ⇒Be wary of sharing your Social Security number.
- ⇒Never use the same password for all your accounts. Try a password manager such as **Last Pass** (www.lastpass.com) and **Dashlane** (www.dashlane.com) to create, store and organize
- passwords for you.

 ⇒Limit the information you share

when using a public wireless

- network in places such as airports.

 ⇒Think carefully before posting about yourself and others online, including vacation photos.
- ⇒Call the Identity Theft Resource Center for Advice at 1-888-400-5530 if you suspect your accounts may have been hacked.
